This office has reviewed the above-mentioned report, which has been submitted to this Ministry as a condition of licensing in accordance with Part VI of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c 0.18. This review is to ensure that the licensed professional consultant archaeologist has met the terms and conditions of their archaeological licence, that archaeological sites have been identified and documented according to the 2011 Standards and Guidelines for Consulting Archaeologists set by the Ministry, and that the archaeological fieldwork and report recommendations ensure the conservation, protection and preservation of the cultural heritage of Ontario.*

As a result of the Stage 3 archaeological assessment, the euro-canadian component of the site was found to be of low cultural heritage value or interest. The First Nations component of the site,

however, was found to hold cultural heritage value or interest and has been recommended for Stage 4 mitigation or avoidance. In our review of the report, we note that Aboriginal communities with a potential interest in the archaeological assessment and mitigation of the site were engaged by the consultant as part of the Stage 3 assessment.

Given the above, this Ministry concurs with the recommendations for archaeological site BfGa-33, referred to as Location 3 in the report, as depicted in Figure 2 of the above titled report and supplementary documentation.

The reports will be accepted into the Ontario Provincial Register of Archaeological Reports.
